## PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Purpose of the B.A.S.I.C.S. Grant was to provide students with the basic essential needs. In supporting these basic needs such as food, clothing and personal hygiene the goal of the grant was to promote positive self esteem and allow students to focus on academic progress rather than fundamental needs.

The program was developed by flyers and brochures being distributed to faculty and staff. Faculty and staff were informed of the opportunity to refer students to the program if a need was noted for any student attending the high school. Student needs were submitted on a referral and then items were given based on needs directly to the students.

Monitoring of attendance and academic progress was done on a monthly basis of those students who needed support on more than three occasions.

Materials and supplies were purchased on an as needed basis. No other material was needed to implement the program /grant.

## STUDENT OUTCOMES

Students who participated were noted to have improved attendance, improved self esteem, improved peer relations and improved class participation.
