Donations may be dropped off in the vestibule next weekend. Thank you.

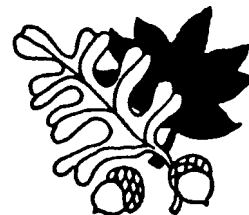
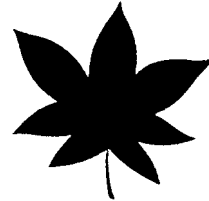
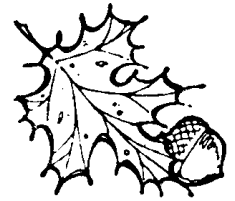
Clinton Road Seniors
